



# 2010 RNS SUMMER SKILLS CAMP EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES - CAMP INSTRUCTORS -

Ringette Nova Scotia is now accepting applications for the positions of Senior and Junior Camp Instructors for the RNS Summer Skills Camps which will be held at the Sackville Sports Stadium, July 5 – 9, 2010 and Cole Harbour Place, August 9 – 13, 2010. Applications may be submitted via fax, mail or email, and must be received by April 30, 2010.

All RNS Summer Camp Instructors will work under the supervision of the Camp Director and On-Ice Instructors, who will assist them with guiding campers through a daily pre-established schedule of on and off ice activities, while ensuring that all campers have a safe, healthy and positive environment. Junior Camp Instructors will also be responsible to the group Senior Camp Instructor.

Please note that unsuccessful applicants for the Senior Camp Instructor positions may be considered for the Junior Camp Instructor positions. Goaltenders **may** be given preference for some of the available positions depending on the number of camp registrants that are goalies.

## **JOB DESCRIPTION: SENIOR CAMP INSTRUCTOR**

### **Qualifications:**

- Minimum 18 years of age or older at the time of the camps.
- Must have sound knowledge of the rules of ringette, at least 4 years experience as a ringette player, and strong skating ability.
- Proven ability to teach ringette and/or skating skills to young children.
- Leadership experience in school or the community.
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance.

### **General Responsibilities:**

- Oversees all daily activities and provides leadership and guidance for a group of approximately 30 camp participants.
- Works closely with the Camp Director, On-Ice Instructors, and other Senior Instructors in planning and coordinating activities.
- Assists On-Ice Instructors in preparing camper progress reports and evaluations.
- Responsible for leading activities in off ice sessions with assistance from the Camp Director.
- Responsible for leading activities in the third daily hour of ice time.
- Provides supervision and guidance to Junior Camp Instructors assigned to group.
- Monitors campers' well-being, safety and whereabouts at all times.
- Reports any accidents or injuries to the Camp Director.
- Acts as an appropriate role model for children through actions, language, work habits and general conduct.
- Attends and participates in all camp staff meetings.
- Present at the program site from 7:30am to 5:30pm daily. (Note: Senior Instructor for U9 Group at Sackville Sports Stadium is required at the program site from 9:00am – 4:00pm daily).
- Other responsibilities and duties as required.

- \$500/week (Note: Senior Instructor for U9 Group at Sackville Sports Stadium will be compensated \$350/week).

- Must be 15 years of age or older at the time of the camps.
- Must have sound knowledge of the rules of ringette, experience as a ringette player, and strong skating skills.
- Volunteer experience in school or the community will be considered an asset.
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance.

**General Responsibilities:**

- Assists Camp Director, Senior Instructors and other camp staff as required.
- Participates enthusiastically in all daily activities with their groups, making camp fun for participants, teaching skills, providing encouragement and support.
- Responsible for reporting group attendance to Senior Instructor on a daily basis.
- Assists On-Ice Instructors and Senior Instructors in preparing camper progress reports and evaluations.
- Acts as an appropriate role model for children through actions, language, work habits and general conduct.
- Attends and participates in all camp staff meetings.
- Present at the program site from 7:30am to 5:30pm daily. (Note: Junior Instructors for U9 Group at Sackville Sports Stadium are required at the program site from 9:00am – 4:00pm daily).
- Other responsibilities and duties as required.
